



*New fire station at the corner of Willow Avenue and First Street (Tamalpais Drive), constructed in 1931 with funds raised by the volunteer firemen. The elected fire chief was a Town employee, and the Town leased office space for the chief from the volunteers. The building housed the Town's fire engines until 1966, when a new public safety building was constructed at Tamalpais and Pixley.*

*Former fire station, sold by the Volunteer Fire Department to the Town in 1966. Since that time, it has served as the Corte Madera Town Hall.*
